<p>Section 8, 1. Brokerage and Risk Transfer Services, A, 1-2. Page 5</p>	<p>Can GCCSA provide copies of all current insurance policies?</p>	<p>GGCSA's Insurance Brokerage RFP process presents an opportunity for a potential vendor to work with GCCSA's management team to develop and implement creative cost management strategies and quality process improvements to maximize risk management decisions. This conceptual opportunity requires the responding broker to identify and define the resources and services they have available which, if the broker is selected, would allow them to respond to the risk management needs of a non-profit community action agency.</p> <p>Upon completion of the selection process, and a contractual agreement signed, the selected vendor will then be expected to review current policies and design a comprehensive risk management program that fits the needs of GCCSA. After the insurance needs are determined and agreed upon, the "Broker" will then be expected to solicit bids from the relevant markets. Therefore, NO BIDS FOR INSURANCE COVERAGE are required to be submitted with the submission packet and will NOT be considered. Potential bidders are expected only to address how they would design a program based on the detailed criteria outlined in the following categories of the RFP in the section titled "<b>7. Scope of Work/Technical Requirements</b>".</p>
<p>Section 8. II. Loss Control and Risk Management, A, 1. Page 5</p>	<p>Can GCCSA provide copies of currently valued loss runs for the last 5 years for all lines of insurance?</p>	<p>This information will be provided to the selected Broker upon completion of the contractual agreement.</p>
<p>Section 8. IV Account Servicing, Pages 7-8</p>	<p>Are any other policies purchased other than those listed on pages 7-8?</p>	<p>There are none known at this time.</p>
<p>Section 11. Proposal Evaluation and Selection. Page 11</p>	<p>Will there be a scoring matrix used in proposal evaluations? If so, can GCCSA provide a copy of the scoring matrix, or advise what scoring criteria is most important to GCCSA?</p>	<p>A scoring matrix will be developed based on the criteria outlined in the RFP.</p>
