Texas Eviction Diversion Program Drive-Up Assistance

GCCSA, Inc. is assisting landlords and tenants as they seek alternative means to eviction

HOUSTON, Texas (November 19, 2020) – Gulf Coast Community Services Association, Inc. (GCCSA, Inc.) is providing a drive-up service to help Harris County tenants and landlords apply for funds in their quest to avert eviction.

The event is on Saturday, November 21, 2020, 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m., 9320 Kirby Drive, at the rear curbside food pantry.

<u>The Texas Eviction Diversion Program (TEDP)</u> is an effort by the state aimed at helping tenants remain in their homes and providing <u>landlords</u> an alternative to eviction. GCCSA, Inc. is the community action agency charged with administering the program in Harris County. The TEDP may provide up to six months of rental assistance for <u>eligible tenants</u> who are behind on their rent because of the COVID-19 pandemic and have been sued for eviction. The program seeks to reduce the number of evictions by enabling landlords and tenants to agree upon a resolution for non-payment of rent.

As a federal CARES Act grantee, GCCSA, Inc. received \$600,000 to assist tenants and landlords. Saturday's event is an opportunity for both parties to ask questions and receive guidance as they fill out the applications for the diversion program. The application first opened on October 20, 2020.
